School Lunch

At this time school lunch will be held inside the classroom. Your child should bring a packed lunch from home. Microwaves are not available at this time.



School Uniforms

We are experiencing delays in receiving our uniforms this year. They are scheduled to arrive by August 20. We ask if you have a TCA uniform shirt that you wear it beginning Monday. If you are a new student or do not have your old shirts, please wear a solid color uniform-style shirt until the order arrives. Khaki bottoms (shorts, pants, or skirts) are required beginning Monday, August 9. Appropriate jeans, with no rips, tears or holes are allowed on Fridays only. Jackets, sweaters, and sweatshirts should be free of hoodies and any writing or graphics.

Extended Day Procedures

Morning and Aftercare for school-aged children will be available beginning Monday at 7:00am. Elementary students will come to the Family Hall. (See picture above). High School students may be dropped off at the HS Hallway doors at 7:00am. Middle School students arriving from 7:00-7:30am should also be dropped off at the HS Building. After 7:30am, MS students report to the MS Building.

All students remaining on campus at 3:15pm will be taken to AfterCare in Family Hall, Elementary Building. At 3:30pm, we begin charging for students remaining on campus.

There is a charge for Morning and AfterCare and all students must be registered and have an account on FACTS for billing of charges. Please call the school office if you have not already registered your child for Extended Day services. (407-243-2211).



Face Masks

Since the beginning of the pandemic the leadership at The Conrad Academy has followed guidelines from the CDC. We have respected the leadership of our local, state and federal government. Last week, Governor DeSantis asked that masks not be mandatory in the classroom, giving parents the right to choose for their child. Science reflects a face mask is a child's only tangible means of protection from COVID, until a vaccine is made available to them. At this time, we will defer to parents regarding your child's face mask. However, it is imperative we consider the other children in the classroom, as well as their teacher. If we see your child is experiencing cold or flu symptoms we will ask you to pick them up.

Please use this self-screening before sending your child to school:

1. In the past 14 day, has my child come in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
2. Is my child experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, body aches, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell?

If the answer is yes to either of these questions, your child should remain home and you should consider having them tested according to CDC guidelines.
